Part I Total Crime

An increase in total Part I Crimes is expected from March to April. The average increase for total Part I Crimes from March to April each year in Pittsfield is about 10%. This year, however, we have had a 29% increase in Part I Crimes.

Violent Crime rates only increased by one incident this month compared to last. On average, though, in Pittsfield, Violent Crime rates tend to drop by about three cases from March to April. While our Violent Crime numbers are still down from where they were when they shot up in 2014, they are still considerably higher than average.

Property Crime rates, on average, increase 15% from March to April, so we had a more drastic rise this month than expected.

Part I Property Crime

This month there was a 125% increase in Burglaries. At face value, this seems a bit disheartening, it can be attributed to the abnormally low number of burglaries for the month of March. In actuality, the burglary rate this month is to be expected, according the five-year average, and is 18% lower than April 2014's burglary rate.

Each individual Property Crime this month had rates very close to what would be expected based on the five-year average.


Part I Violent Crime

The trend of high Aggravated Assault rates continues this month. By April last year, there had only been 7 Aggravated Assaults for the entire year, but by the end of this month, we have already had 48 Aggravated Assault incidents in 2015. The first few months in 2014 admittedly had unusually low Violent Crime rates, but our 14 Aggravated Assault cases put us 75% higher than even the average for the same crime.


So far this year, we are at approximately twice the total number of Violent Crimes than we were last year. Aggravated Assaults are the culprit for the high overall total, but that disparity has been prevented from becoming even higher due to the low number of other types of violent incidents. There have been 33% fewer rape cases this year compared to last, and 50% fewer robberies.




A Closer Look: Part I Violent Crime




A Closer Look: Burglary




