Part I Total Crime

After an unfortunate spike in crime during the month of June, July has proven to be a very good month for the city of Pittsfield. All but one Part I Crime showed a decrease from last month's totals, and all but two categories had a lower number of incidents than were anticipated based on the Five-Year Average.

This is also the **first month** in the year 2014 where we have had a below-average Property Crime Rate, with July showing 2% less crime in that category than the average since 2009. This is a huge improvement, since other months this year have shown Property Crime rates as much as 48% above average.

Part I Property Crime

July 2014 showed a 12% decrease in Property Crime since June. This is especially impressive given that, on average, Property Crime from June to July *increases* by 5%.

Most individual Property Crimes showed a lower-than-average number of incidents for July. Even those two crimes, Burglary and Miscellaneous Larceny, that showed higher-than-average rates were closer to the expected average than they were last month. In June, Burglary was higher than average and Misc. Larceny was 28% higher, while this month they are both only 12% higher than expected.


Part I Violent Crime

The chart below shows a very positive outlook on Violent Crime in Pittsfield. We have had the same or fewer cases of Violent Crime across the board compared to last month. We have also had fewer Violent Crimes than expected when looking at the Five Year Average, in all categories.


Even those two red blocks, when looked at critically, forecast a decline in violence in the city. Last month, Rape cases were 63% higher than they were at the same time in 2013. This month, there is only an 8% difference, which shows that we are bridging the gap. Similarly, Robbery cases were 43% higher than 2013 in June, but this month they are only 29% higher.


