Part I Total Crime

On average, there is typically an uptick in crime as the summer rolls. This year, though, we actually had a 14% decrease in overall Part I Crime from May to June. There is usually about an 18% increase in Property Crime in Pittsfield from May to June, but this year, there was a 12% decrease. There is an average 0% change in Violent Crimes between these months, but we were fortunate enough to have an 18% decrease this month compared to last. The decrease in Violent Crimes this year is particularly notable since in 2014, from May to June, Violent Crimes increased by 475%.

Part I Property Crime

Typically June is a month when we start to see the yearly increase in burglaries that usually continues through August. This year, however, burglaries actually went down by **33%**. In fact, the only Part I Property Crime with a higher-than-average number of cases this year was shoplifting. Even that may, in actuality, reflect increased security measures in local stores enabling greater accuracy in detecting and catching shoplifters. Overall, Property Crime numbers for Pittsfield this month are

encouraging.



Part I Violent Crime

June of last year was the first time we saw Aggravated Assault rates jump from record lows to record highs, with an increase from 0 cases in May to 16 in one month's time. While the overall number of Aggravated Assault cases each month remains relatively high, it would be normal for this month's total to increase by about 50% compared to last month. In actuality, the number of these cases decreased by 25%. That leaves us with a total number of Part I Violent Crimes 18% lower than May's total. There is still work to be done, though, since Aggravated Assaults were still 75% higherthan-average this month.













A Closer Look: CHANGING CRIME TRENDS



The charts above help visualize the changing crime trends that we are seeing in Pittsfield. Property Crime rate trends are consistent with previous years, and, so far, are mostly lower-than-average. Violent Crime rate trends, on the other hand, are differing quite a bit from the normal rises and falls. Although Violent Crime rates are still much higher than average, there was a steep rise last in Violent Crime last June, but this June the Violent Crime rate actually fell.
